As you can see from the most recent photos taken by the drone camera the new school building is coming on at a pace. More images can be seen on the school website

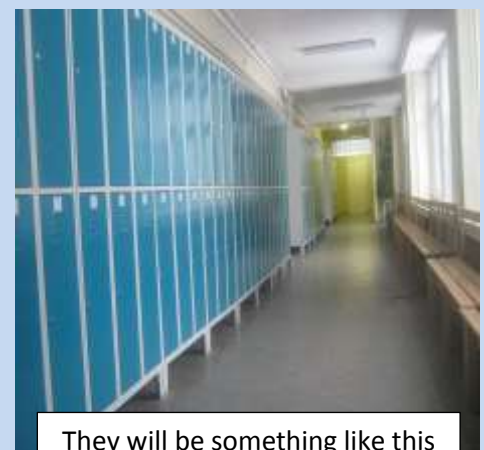
We are getting into a very busy and hectic time in relation to the building works as we are starting to order new furniture and equipment ready for the move.

One of the things that the children are very excited about is that in the new building children from Y2 – Y6 will no longer have coat pegs. Each child will have their own locker.

The children will then have to keep **all** their personal belongings in the locker, this includes their coat, PE kit, packed lunch box etc. So when you are thinking about next year the children will need smaller bags to in order to fit everything

in, perhaps a more traditional PE bag rather than a hefty ruck sack. It will mean that the children's things will be all kept together in one place and not being knocked off coat pegs landing on floors to be walked on, or 'moved' along corridors. We are hoping that lockers will mean we can keep the corridors cleaner and tidier, which is even more important as we will of course have classes upstairs and we don't want coats or PE kits on the stairs. We also envisage that there will be less lost property as the children's possessions will be more securely stored.
