- What level are they given?
  - 3 different standards
  - working towards, working at, greater depth
  - reading, writing, maths and science

# Reading

What evidence do we use?

- guided reading notes
- comprehension tasks
- test papers

How should they be reading?

- fluency and expression
- talk about what they have read

- Complete practice papers so they get used to the layout
- Different question types

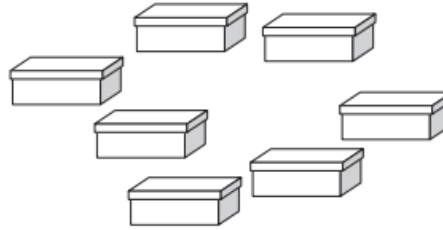
